When referring to a chapter in an authored book, usually you would not cite that chapter in the reference list. Instead, you would cite the whole book and, if necessary, cite the chapter in text. This rule applies whether the chapter is written by one of the book's primary authors or by a separate contributor.

The general format below refers to a book with eight or more authors. If the book is edited, refer to the Chapter in edited book/ebook tab in this box. For the in-text citation for a book with eight or more authors or editors, include the first author or editor and then 'et al.'

Proper Bibliographic Reference Format: Bibliographic references are double-spaced and indented half an inch after the first line. Only the book title is in italics. The editor's initials precede the family name. Use "sentence-style" capitalization. Note: for books with a large editorial board, list the name of the lead editor, followed by et al.

If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author's name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number. For the Reference page, make sure you include the author, chapter title, editor, book title, page range, and publication information.

How To Cite a Chapter From a Book in APA Format

While APA requires italics for the title of a book, the title of a chapter in a book goes in regular type. Provide the information for the book's editor and the book after the chapter title: Author's last name, first Initial(s).

If there are different authors for each chapter, you need to reference EACH chapter you use.; If you use multiple chapters from a book with different authors for each chapter, you still need to reference EACH chapter you use.(This is because you need to acknowledge who wrote the work you are using, not the person who edited/compiled the book).
