Oman Labour Law

In Oman, the labour law provides a maximum of 45 hours of work per week. That's roughly 9 hours a day. But, during the Ramadan season, employees work for just 6 hours a day or 30 hours a week. Overtime . Employees are entitled to overtime if they are paid.

The Oman Labor Law applies not just to Omani employers and employees but also to non-Omani, meaning to expats as well. All private sector employees, not including domestic workers and Omani civil and security personnel, are under this law. Oman Labour Law. 20. Article 73. The employer shall grant the employee, in respect of the cases provided for in the preceding Article, an extra salary equivalent to the salary to which he is entitled for the overtime period plus 25% at least for e day time working hours, and 50% for night time working hours.

Oman Labour Law - Gulf Talent

Oman Labour Law was amended during February of 2010 to allow the formation of Labour Unions. There are now approximately 70 Labour Unions within the Sultanate. The law forbids a strike for any reason. Collective bargaining is not permitted, however there exist labour-management committees in firms with more than 50 workers.

Provisions of the Labour Laws in Oman - Law Teacher

Oman's Labor Law is stipulated by the Royal Decree 35/2003, and is issued by the Sultanate of Oman regarding all laws pertaining to Labor and employment-related issues.

Article 39 of the Oman Labor Law states that: On the termination of the relation of work of the workers who are not beneficiaries of the Social Insurance Law the employer shall by the worker a post service gratuity in the amount of the wage of fifteen days for each year of service for the first three years, and the wage of one month for each of the following years.

Gratuity as per Oman Labor Law

Every employee in Oman is entitled to a certain amount of annual leave and sick leave days as per the Oman Labour Law. Here's what the law says... Annual leave. Once employees complete one year of service, they're entitled to 15 days of annual leave with basic salary, which increases to 30 days for every year after that.
