### Virtual Chapel - Trinity College

Trinity College is a constituent college of the University of Cambridge in England. The college was founded in 1546 by King Henry VIII.With around 600 undergraduates, 300 graduates, and over 180 fellows, it is the largest college in either of the Oxbridge universities by number of undergraduates. In terms of total student numbers, it is second only to Homerton College, Cambridge.

### Chapel History - Trinity College

The Great Organ in the Trinity College Chapel was installed in 1954 by the firm of Casavant Frères of Sainte-Hyacinthe, Québec, after a consultation that included the eminent musicians Dr. Healey Willan and Sir Ernest MacMillan. As experts will recognize, this was before the Organ Reform Movement swept across North America.

During term-time, the Choir of Trinity College is primarily involved in the singing of services in the College Chapel. Evensong is sung twice a week, with the exception of two Sundays a year, when the Choir sings a Choral Eucharist.

### Trinity College Chapel - organ

The chapel has been changed little since it was built. The stained glass was added in 1885, the gift of the then Bursar, later President, Henry Woods. ### Music at the Chapel - Trinity College

Trinity College Chapel is the chapel of Trinity College, Cambridge, a constituent college of the University of Cambridge.Part of a complex of Grade I listed buildings at Trinity, it dates from the mid 16th Century. It is an Anglican church in the Anglo-Catholic tradition.. History. The chapel was begun in 1554-55 by order of Queen Mary and was completed in 1567 by her half-sister, Elizabeth I.

Trinity's magnificent mechanical-action organ is regarded as one of the finest organs in the United Kingdom. The original instrument was built by the famous 'Father' Smith in 1694 and 1706. Over the years many alterations were made, until in 1913 an almost totally new organ was built, on a massive scale.

The college's organ was built in 1964 by the well-known organ builders Harrison & Harrison. The organ has since remained relatively unchanged (in 1974 Harrison & Harrison returned to the instrument to increase the size of the Great division and to make other small changes). The organ case and loft are situated on the west side of the Chapel.

Clarence Watters (Professor of Music and Trinity College organist from 1932-1969) was consultant for the college's pipe organ, installed in 1971 by Austin Organs, Inc. of Hartford, Connecticut.
